2007 Holiday Trash Pickup

There will be no solid waste, yard waste or recycling pickup in the City of Oviedo on the following holidays during 2007:

Trash should be placed on the curb **AFTER 6:00 P.M.** on the day prior to scheduled pickup. All household waste should be placed in **sealed, hard side containers** to prevent wildlife and roaming animals from scattering the contents. HOUSEHOLD TRASH SHOULD NOT BE PLACED CURBSIDE OVERNIGHT IN WHITE PLASTIC BAGS.
